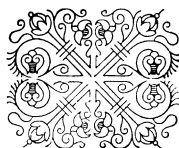

 ONLY those who have attempted the compilation of a Stud Book of an animal concerning which no previous attempt has been made, can form an idea of its difficulties, and the compiler, in many instances, fails to obtain help from those he imagined would be most forward to render it. At any rate, he can be beforehand with his critics, by assuring them there are few defects in the present work which he does not acknowledge and allow, and yet trusts it will be received by the N.C.C. and those who are at present outsiders, as an honest attempt to rough hew and clear the way for those who shall succeed him in the task. It is only necessary to peruse the names of the present officials of the Club, to find men of most varied professions and sympathies, who have been drawn together by their common affection for and appreciation of the Cat. TERMS OF MEMBERSHIP.

N.C.C.

The N.C.C. owes its origin to some dozen ladies and gentlemen, met together on June 15th, 1887, at the Alexandra Palace, on the second day of a four-day Cat Show. After the subject had been discussed, MR. A. A. CLARKE was appointed Hon. Treasurer, and then and there collected in subscriptions from those present, about £6. A gentleman elected Co-Secretary with MISS GRESHAM, failed to put in a second appearance, and of those original Members, owing to death and change, only MR. CLARKE, MRS. ELLERTON, MRS. HORTON, and MISS JEVONS, remain on the Club at the present time. On the following 18th of October, the first "General Meeting" was held at the Crystal Palace during the Cat Show, a report of which is given in the first entry on our Minute Book (attested by F. GRESHAM). There we find, among others present, were MR. HARRISON WEIR, first President, in the Chair, A. A. CLARKE, first and present Treasurer, MISS GRESHAM, the first Honorary Secretary, and eight others. MR. HARRISON WEIR, resigning in 1890, was succeeded by the present President, LOUIS WAIN. MR. J. W. TOWNSEND took the place of MISS GRESHAM, in which office he was succeeded in 1891 by the present Honorary Secretary. The Stud Book and Register (for both sexes are entered), was commenced under the auspices of the late Honorary Secretary, and the first entry form received, dated July 31st, 1890, was entered on the Stud Book, 1001.

The object of the National Cat Club cannot be better summed up than in the concluding words of the second paragraph of the Club "Rules and Regulations," namely, *to do all in its power to protect and advance the interest of the Cat.*"

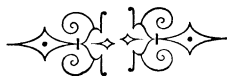

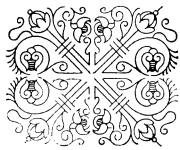
